



Dear Parents,

While your child is the Star of the Week, each day of the week will consist of an exciting event or activity to honor him or her and help us get to know our special classmate better. Monday: Show and Share - The "Star of the Week" will bring in a completed poster. The poster will be sent home the week before your child's week. The "star" will share the poster with the class and it will hang in the classroom for the week.

Tuesday: Morning Meeting Greeting/Activity - The "star" will choose the greeting and activity during the morning meeting.

Wednesday: Parent Letter - Parents, you will write a letter to the class telling us how special your child is to you. Send the letter in a sealed envelope to school with your child, and I will read the letter to the class. The content of the letter is up to you, but you may want to choose from one of the following ideas: Answer the following, "What makes my child special?" Describe special or funny stories about your child for the class to hear, write a silly or serious poem about your child, tell us some neat things we may not know about your child, or send silly or special pictures with a letter describing the pictures.

Thursday: Favorite Book - The "Star of the Week" will bring in his favorite book. It can be read aloud by the student or the teacher. If it is a chapter book, the student can choose a chapter to be read.

Friday: Certificate/Book/Prize Box - The "star" will choose a prize from the prize box and be presented with a special certificate. He/she will be presented with a book containing positive letters from fellow classmates.
